During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be 350 runs online (50%), 350 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

-You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable. No FAX or emailed entries will be accepted. No hand delivered entries can be accepted in the first 24 hours.

-Limit of 10 dogs per envelope

-All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms one dog per entry form.

-Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC Agreement are not acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are not acceptable.

-If you would like a confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard.

-Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

After Closing Wait List

A waiting list (30 run maximum each day) will be maintained for these trials once they have closed on March 30. The waiting list will be active until its deadline – Monday, April 11, 6:00 pm CT. Any runs that are entered in these trials at closing and pulled before the waiting list deadline will be replaced, if possible, by runs in order on the waiting list, and the exhibitor will be reimbursed in full. **If a run cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the run.** Entry Fees for runs on the waiting list that do not get into the trial by the waiting list closing date will be refunded in full.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all Australian Shepherds fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP).

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind, bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are not eligible to compete. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

Move-ups

For the Friday, April 15, trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CT, April 11. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation for the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday, April 16 and Sunday, April 17 trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial day on Friday, April 15, and Saturday, April 16 respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Mailed/emailed move-ups close at 6:00pm CT on Monday, April 11.

Height Divisions

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

AKC Jump Height Cards

All dogs competing in agility must possess an official AKC Jump Height Card. **You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form if your dog needs to be measured.** For more information, please visit http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm.

Obstacles

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC regulations for Agility Trials.

Class Description

Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions.

Change of Entry

As described in Chapter 1, Section 21 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a dog which is entered in a Novice A class for which it is not eligible may be moved to Novice B. In addition, if notification has been received in writing from the AKC after closing that a dog is not eligible for a class entered, the dog may be moved to the correct class. The request for the move must be made at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

Entering for Exhibition only (FEO) *NOT OFFERED AT THIS TRIAL*

- FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (eg. When checkin in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or the PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both in Regular OR both in Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 241-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A **separate entry form must be submitted** when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

The United States Australian Shepherd Association may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions.

Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$10.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification (including a signed veterinary note) of such a claim 30 minutes before judging commences.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The United States Australian Shepherd Association has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$30 returned check fee.

No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

Checks for pulled or unacceptable entries will be shredded. No checks will be returned. Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials. The United States Australian Shepherd Association does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. This includes properly disposing of waste and using designated relief areas.

Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult at all times when on the grounds.

All dogs must be on-leash at all times (except when crated, at the warm up jumps, or as required to be judged).

Exhibitors accept personal liability with respect to any claim in respect to any damage or injury caused by their dog(s) in their possession.



Trial Information

Setup on Thursday will be limited to Committee Members and those helping set the rings ONLY. If you would like to volunteer to help set up the rings on Thursday, please contact Judy Cull via the online sign-up form that will be sent with Final Confirmations. Trial hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after completion.

Ring size is 90 x 105 (two rings).

Electronic timing will be used at these trials

The building is climate-controlled. There is plenty of close parking and crate space.

Please bring chairs and crates. Please bring a pad or mat to place under your crates NO SMOKING or VAPING is allowed in the building.

Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) may be brought into the Event Center.

Coronavirus Information and Guidelines

With the changing guidelines that are being required due to the COVID-19, we are continually revising our plans for everyone's safety.

Competitors shall wear masks, (provided by them) at all times within the building and in accordance with the facility rules.

Social distancing (6 feet) requirements will be in effect.

Competitors may eat inside the building at their crating area and the café area and may temporarily remove their mask to do so.

*High in Trial Agility Junior will be awarded to the Junior Handler who is a member of USASA and who is handling an Australian Shepherd that the junior owns or co-owns. This junior with the greatest number of qualifying runs on the national specialty day. The first tie breaker will be cumulative score and the second tie breaker will be cumulative yards per second for qualifying runs in STD and JWW classes. The junior must have an AKC Junior Handler #.

RV Information

Coordination of the RV parking will be done through the Purina Farms Events Center. Purina Farms offers two different RV lots on property. The Full-Service Purina Event Center RV lot offers water and sewer, as well as 30 and 50 amp electric. The electric only Main Show Field RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric. Spaces are assigned first come, first served. See the Purina RV Map if you want to request a specific spot.

There is a nightly charge of \$40 in the Full-Service Purina Event Center Lot and \$25 in the Electric Only Main Show Field RV Lot. Reservations need to be paid in full within 2 days of receiving a confirmation email. Full payment by credit card must be received before the space can be confirmed and finalized. Credit cards only.

The first night of camping cannot be before April 13 and your stay must end by April 22. Check-in is no earlier than 3 pm on the arrival date; check-out time is no later than 6 pm on your departure date (dates will be shown on your reservation confirmation).

NOTE: Water is not available in the full-service lot from Nov 1 - Apr 14.

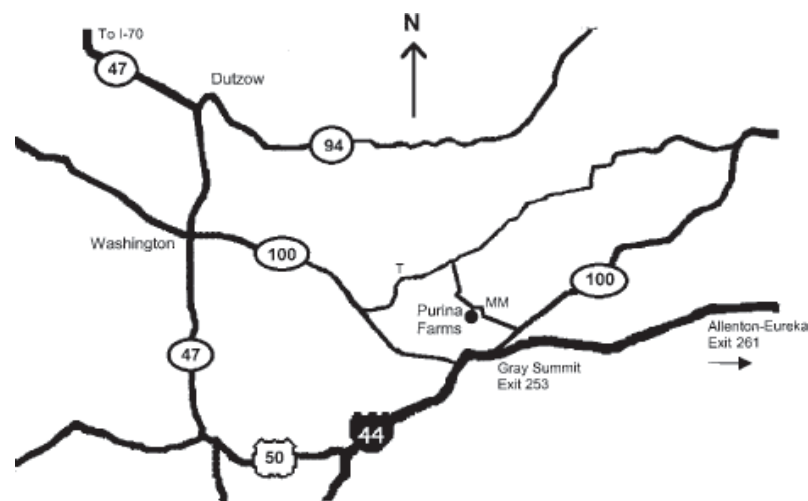
Exhibitors will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their spaces. Discharge onto the grounds is not permitted. Anyone abusing this privilege may forfeit future parking spaces and could be subject to disciplinary action by the Event Committee, including expulsion from this and all future trials.

All exhibitors must be responsible for cleaning up after their dogs on the motel, RV and trial grounds. Motels require that dogs be crated when unattended. Any damages to motels, RV sites or the trial site can result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee. It is expected that exhibitors will clean up immediately after their own dogs and strongly encourage others to do the same.

All owners/exhibitors should be aware that the entire motel grounds and RV sites are considered within the trial grounds. You will be responsible for all damage to your room/site and may be subject to disciplinary action in accordance with the rules of the AKC. Any abuse of the grounds will be brought to the attention of the trial-giving club and its Event Committee. Any exhibitor's entries may be refused for previous misuse of the motel or RV facilities. This is an AKC supported measure.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
